

## PARKING

Parking will not be allowed on-site. However, parking is available along Brayton Lane and other local streets.

## MEETING POINT

We will collect all children at the school gates (yellow box above and as shown to the right) at 10am. We will collect children from the small gate - the car entrance will be closed - and strictly no parents are allowed to pass this point. We will take all children in together, so please be ready for 10am.



## COLLECTION POINT

Children to be collected from the same area at 3pm. Again, no adults are allowed to enter the school grounds.

## DURING THE CAMP




## SET UP OF INSIDE SPACE



- We will be strictly following a one-way system when inside.
- Children will enter through the main door and their hands will be sanitized in the yellow area.
- They will then follow the one-way system and put their things in the designated classroom (red rectangle).
- In the classroom, the children will be allocated their own table where they will also eat at during lunch and breaks- the table outlay is shown in the image to the right. However, if we can, we will eat outside
- When the children need the toilet, a member of staff will take them and wait outside. The toilet will be sprayed with disinfectant following each use and only 1 child may enter at a time.
- Staff will ensure that hands have been washed.
- Whenever the children come back into the building, they will be asked to wash their hands.
- Children will only enter the following areas: entrance way, hall, designated classroom, corridor to the toilets and the toilets. These will be cleaned and disinfected after each day.

## SET UP OF OUTDOOR SPACE




- Children will wash their hands before going outside and when they come back in.
- Children will be allocated a zone in the child area to put their water bottle and any other items they may need.
- Children will not be able to share any drinks at all.
- Only equipment that is needed will be set up on the pitches and children will be asked not to touch any other equipment.
- Any other equipment will be stored in the coach area.
- During any inputs, the coaches will stay in the coach area and the children in their area. A small number of children will then be used to demonstrate drills, but they will keep 1 metre apart.
- In hot/wet weather, the areas will be set up underneath the tree.
- A maximum of 8 children will work in either half of the football pitches.
- If children need the toilet, a member of staff will take them and wait outside. The toilet will be sprayed with disinfectant following each use and only 1 child may enter at a time.




## EXTRA PRECAUTIONS



Children will be kept 1 metre apart



Equipment will be counted and collected each day. It will all be disinfected after each day/session. Children will not be asked to pick up any equipment at all.



Don't send children in if they are showing any symptoms.



Please ensure you send in plenty to drink and a packed lunch with enough food to keep them going for a day of physical activity.



Coaches will wear PPA when dealing with any first aid.



Please can any cash payments be put into a sealed and named envelope.
